### TRANSACTIONS:

- Signed by Miami as an unrestricted free agent from New England on March 21, 2020.
- 6th-round pick (221st overall) by New England in the 2016 NFL draft.

### CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

- Played in 76 career games with 36 starts.
- Appeared in 10 postseason games with 1 start.
- Won Super Bowls LI and LIII with New England.

- Started all 16 games at center.
- Served as a team captain.
