Atlanta Falcons Linebacker De’Vondre Campbell (transcribed by Rachel White)

(What was it like coming from a junior college?) – “It was hard definitely going to a junior college, because the junior college I went to is kind of like an NFL team where only a certain amount of guys can make the team being an out of state player, so it was hard being there. I went there so young, so it just really forced me to grow up quick. I attribute a lot of my maturity now to going to junior college at such an early age and forcing myself to grow up quick.”

(Last time you were here in this building, it was a bowl game. What was it like this time in the third preseason game?) – “It was different. It was a completely different environment. I’m a pro now, and I think it’s really starting to set in that I am actually in the NFL.”

(Coach said that everything they throw at you, it seems like you’re taking it. How much are you swimming, and how much are you just kind of thriving in what they are giving you in first team?) – “I think I’m doing really good. I don’t get nervous. I don’t get rattled. Every time they throw something new at me, I take it like a grain of salt and adjust on the go. I think I’ve been doing really good. Coach thinks I’ve been doing really good. I am a typical rookie – I make mistakes, but the biggest thing is to correct them and keep pushing.”
