## On enhancing 3<sup>rd</sup> down awareness and overall performance:

"When you get opportunities you make the most of it. Just working at it and being more focused in certain areas compared to others. I feel like I've had a lot of opportunities to do just that. I make the most of some, but others I fall short. That's okay I'm not perfect. I'll continue to work at it. I know what I need to continue to work on going forward."

### On the performance of the offensive line:

"They did a great job of winning at the line of scrimmage and keeping the defenders on their side of the ball so that we can be patient and press it and make those cuts. They did a great job opening those lanes. As a runner you drool over things like that. Just running behind them is just awesome. I'm very thankful and I've got to make the most of every opportunity."

### On QB Tony Romo's positive comments about becoming more comfortable in the RB position:

"In OTA's I struggled a lot more. I still have a lot to learn. There are little things that I need to fine tune. Compared to OTA's, training camp is a night and day difference. I feel like I caught on a lot better the second time around then I did the first time. Understanding what they're trying to do on certain plays, the schemes; it just makes it a lot easier. When you can play without thinking you play a lot faster. You play more comfortable."
