(Obviously you guys aren't into the moral victory thing but you put together a comeback, especially in the second half. With the way you guys have struggled in the second half this year, is this something you can build on or take away from?) – "I don't know. Like you said, there are no moral victories; but I think it doesn't help when you know that you are capable of it. We've known that forever. We've just got to go out there and consistently do it and finish. That's why we've lost so many games. We've been in every game, for the most part, and we haven't been able to finish."

(You guys were playing a good defensive team and the offense looked as good as it has all season. Do you feel like there's some momentum building offensively?) – "Our offensive line did a great job. We can't shoot ourselves in the foot. I dropped the ball and it led to a pick. I feel like I lost us the game. If you ask me, I feel like with the momentum coming out of the half, I don't feel like they stopped us. I feel like we stopped ourselves and I feel like I lost us the game."

(The play you say you feel like you cost the team, what happened? Did you just lose it?) – "I just dropped the ball. (Colin) Kaepernick made a good ball but I just dropped it. There's no excuses. It popped up in the air. It's embarrassing, to be honest."
