#### Bills LB Lorenzo Alexander (transcribed by the Buffalo Bills)

**Q: We know Kyle [Williams] on the field, and the impact he leaves, but he might not be a bad guy to follow [off the field] either, right?**

A: Yeah, not at all. He's done it the right way. He's showed you how you create longevity in this league. I think often at times, people just assume it's all about what you do on the field. A lot of times, it's about how you live your life. He's a guy that – really, it lines up; what he's preaching and what he's talking about is how he lives, with his wife and with his kids. When that's right, you can come to work [with] a clear mind, and you don't have distractions, it allows you to put all your energy into it. He does a great job of doing both things well. I think guys see that and recognize he's genuine, and they fall in line.

**Q: How cool would it be, not only for the team but obviously for him – has never played in a playoff game, there's a few other guys here that haven't – you guys keep plugging along to get in that position?**

A: Well that's the goal. You never know when you're going to have this opportunity again. You have to cherish every moment. Obviously, a guy like that, you want the most for him because he's always done it the right way. But I know he's going to say a playoff game is not good enough to him, he wants to win one. That's why he plays, not just to get in the dance, but at the end, hold the trophy up. With that, we have to take it one week at a time; have to put ourselves in that position first, and then we'll take it there if we get into the dance.

**Q: The Dolphins have been playing so well offensively as of late, you guys really held them out of the end zone until the end. What was the key today going into the game and the execution?**

A: The big thing was stopping [Kenyan] Drake early on. He had some runs, but they weren't really too explosive. They got away from it, put the ball in Jay's [Cutler] hands, and he threw us some picks. Guys capitalized on the ones he overthrew, and threw to them, and I think that's what ultimately came down to it at the end. We were able to put some pressure on them, whether it was [Cap] Capi, Jerry [Hughes], Kyle, Eddie [Yarbrough]; just a good up front, four-man rush today, I thought. I think that kind of gave them some issues as well.
