



NFL CAREER

TRANSACTIONS:

- 4th-round pick (125th overall) by Miami in the 2014 NFL draft.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

- Played in 93 career games with 4 starts.
- 46 tackles (33 solo), 2 interceptions and 3 passes defended.
- 47 special teams tackles (37 solo) and 1 forced fumble.
- Missed just 2 games in his 6-year NFL career.
- Recorded the first defensive 2-point conversion in Dolphins history when he returned a blocked PAT vs. Arizona (12/11/16).

2019 (MIAMI):

- Played in 15 games.
- Inactive for 1 game.
- 13 tackles (8 solo) and 1 pass defended.
- 8 special teams tackles (7 solo).

VS. BALTIMORE (9/8): 6 tackles (3 solo).

VS. NEW ENGLAND (9/15): 2 solo special teams tackles.

AT DALLAS (9/22): 5 tackles (4 solo).

2018 (MIAMI):

- Played in all 16 games with 1 start.
- 2 tackles (1 solo), 1 interception and 1 pass defended; 9 special teams tackles (7 solo).
- Served as a season-long team captain.

AT NEW ENGLAND (9/30): 2 special teams tackles (1 solo).

VS. N.Y. JETS (11/4): 1 interception and 1 pass defended.

- Intercepted QB Sam Darnold on 4th-and-10 with 41 seconds remaining in the game to seal Miami's 13-6 victory.

AT INDIANAPOLIS (11/25): 1 solo tackle and 2 solo special teams tackles.

2017 (MIAMI):

- Played in all 16 games.
- 2 solo tackles.
- 7 special teams tackles (4 solo) and 1 forced fumble.

AT NEW ENGLAND (11/26): 2 special teams tackles and 1 special teams forced fumble.

- Forced WR Danny Amendola to fumble a punt at New England's 28-yard line in the 3rd quarter.

AT KANSAS CITY (12/24): 2 special teams tackles (1 solo).

VS. BUFFALO (12/31): 1 solo tackle and 2 special teams tackles (1 solo).

2016 (MIAMI):

- Played in 15 games.
- Inactive for 1 contest.
- 7 special teams tackles (4 solo).

VS. ARIZONA (12/11): Defensive 2-point conversion.

- Returned a defensive 2-point conversion following a DT Jordan Phillips blocked PAT in the 4th quarter to extend Miami's lead to 23-15.

- The defensive 2-point conversion was the first in team history.

AT N.Y. JETS (12/17): 1 assisted special teams tackle and 1 blocked punt.

- Blocked a P Lachlan Edwards punt and returned it 11 yards for a TD.

- It was Miami's first blocked punt return for a TD since 2012.

POSTSEASON:

AFC WILD CARD AT PITTSBURGH (1/8): 1 special teams tackle.

2015 (MIAMI):

- Played in all 16 games with 4 starts.
- 20 tackles (15 solo).
- 10 special teams tackles (9 solo).

AT WASHINGTON (9/13): 2 solo tackles and 1 solo special teams stop.

- Made 1st career start.

AT JACKSONVILLE (9/20): 4 tackles (2 solo).

AT PHILADELPHIA (11/15): 6 tackles (5 solo) and 3 special teams stops.

- His 6 tackles were a season high.

2014 (MIAMI):

- Played in 15 games.
- Inactive for 1 contest.
- 9 tackles (7 solo), 1 interception, 1 pass defended.
- 6 solo special teams tackles.

VS. NEW ENGLAND (9/7): 1 special teams tackle.

- Made NFL debut.

AT OAKLAND IN OAKLAND (9/28): 1 interception.

- Picked off QB Matt McGloin for his 1st career

interception and returned it 43 yards in the 4th quarter.

AT NEW ENGLAND (12/14): 4 tackles (3 solo).

- His 4 tackles were a season high.

BEFORE THE NFL

COLLEGE (LIBERTY):

- 3-year starter (2011-13).
- Transferred from Illinois after his freshman season (2009).

CAREER (AT LIBERTY): Played in 34 games with 31 starts for Liberty; 162 tackles (120 solo), 3 sacks, 7 interceptions, 20 passes defended and 6 forced fumbles.

SENIOR (2013 AT LIBERTY): Played in 12 games with 10 starts; 62 tackles (50 solo), 3 interceptions, 6 passes defended, 3.5 tackles for loss and 1 sack; 2 punt returns for 2 yards (1.0 avg.); 2 kickoff returns for 57 yards (28.5 avg.).

- His 62 tackles were tied for the team lead.
- 1st-team All-Big South.

JUNIOR (2012 AT LIBERTY): Played in 11 games with 10 starts; 51 tackles (39 solo), 1 interception, 6 passes defended and 3 forced fumbles; 4 punt returns for 42 yards (10.5 avg.).

- His 51 tackles led the team's defensive backs.
- His 3 forced fumbles were tied for most in the conference.
- 2nd-team All-Big South.

REDSHIRT SOPHOMORE (2011 AT LIBERTY): Started all 11 games; 49 tackles (31 solo), 3 interceptions, 3 forced fumbles and 2 sacks.

- 2nd-team All-Big South.

SOPHOMORE (2010): Redshirted after transferring to Liberty.

TRUE FRESHMAN (2009 AT ILLINOIS): Played in 10 games with 5 starts; 32 tackles (26 solo) and 2

passes defended.

- All-Big Ten Freshman team.

HIGH SCHOOL (HARDING UNIVERSITY – CHARLOTTE, N.C.)

- Played quarterback and defensive back.
- Also played basketball for his father, Walter, who was the school's head basketball coach.

SENIOR (2008): Threw for 1,500 yards and 15 TDs; Rushed for 565 yards and 5 TDs; Recorded 6 interceptions.

- All-Queen City Conference Offensive Player of the Year.
- 1st-team all-conference on defense.
- Earned The Gridiron Great award.
