### CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

- Played in 86 career games.
- 310 punts for 14,251 yards (46.0 avg.) and a 41.3 net average.
- 6 special teams tackles (5 solo).
- Played in 3 postseason games – 2 with New England and 1 with Miami.
- His 40.7 net punt average in 2023 was the 5th-best in franchise history:

- His 71 punt return yards allowed in 2020 were the fewest in Patriots history and the 7th-fewest in NFL history.

#### 2024 (MIAMI):

- Played in 11 games.
- 35 punts for 1,638 yards (46.8 avg.) and a 40.0 net average.
- 1 solo special teams tackle.

**VS. JACKSONVILLE (9/8):** 4 punts for 198 yards (49.5 avg.) and a 48.8 net average.

- Pinned 3-of-4 punts inside the 20.

**AT INDIANAPOLIS (10/20):** 6 punts for 286 yards (47.7 avg.) and a 45.5 net average.

- Pinned 3-of-6 punts inside the 20.

## 2020 (NEW ENGLAND):

- Played in all 16 games.
- 55 punts for 2,678 yards (48.7 avg.) and a 45.6 net average.
- His 45.6 net punt average led the NFL and was the best single-season net punt average in Patriots history.
- His 71 punt return yards allowed were the fewest in Patriots history and the 7th-fewest in NFL history.

**AT KANSAS CITY (10/5):** 3 punts for 157 yards (52.3 avg.) and a 52.3 net average.

- Pinned all 3 punts inside the 20.

**AT L.A. RAMS (12/10):** 6 punts for 310 yards (51.7 avg.) and a 50.3 net average.

- Pinned 4 of 6 punts inside the 20.

**VS. BUFFALO (12/28):** 7 punts for 362 yards (51.7 avg.) and a 48.1 net average.

- Pinned 4 of 7 punts inside the 20.

## 2019 (NEW ENGLAND):

- His 43.8 career punt avg. was the best in school history.

- 2nd-team All-Pac 12.

• His 44.1 punt average was 4th-best in school history.

**JUNIOR (2017):** Played in all 14 games; 57 punts for 2,586 yards (45.4 avg.); 1 carry for 17 yards.

- 2nd-team All-Pac 12.

• His 45.4 punt average led the Pac-12 and ranked 7th nationally.

**SOPHOMORE (2016):** Played in all 13 games; 50 punts for 2,176 yards (43.5 avg.).
