COLLEGE (NOTRE DAME [OH]):

- 4-year starter (2014-17).
- Transferred from California (PA) following his redshirt freshman season (2013).

CAREER (AT NOTRE DAME [OH]): Played in 42 games with 39 starts; 191 tackles (107 solo), 26 sacks, 1 interception, 6 passes defended and 5 forced fumbles.

- Left school as the program's all-time career leader in sacks (26) and tackles for loss (43.5).
- His 5 forced fumbles tied the school's career record.
- Finished his career 4th in school history in tackles (191) and 2nd in solo stops (107).

SENIOR (2017 AT NOTRE DAME [OH]): Started all 11 games; 58 tackles (37 solo), 8.5 sacks and 3 forced fumbles.

- 1st-team All-MEC.
- His 8.5 sacks were 6th in MEC.

JUNIOR (2016 AT NOTRE DAME [OH]): Played in all 11 games with 11 starts; 47 tackles (25 solo), 5.5 sacks and 2 passes defended.

- 1st-team All-MEC.

SOPHOMORE (2015 AT NOTRE DAME [OH]):

Started all 11 games; 60 tackles (27 solo), 7 sacks, 1 interception, 4 passes defended and 2 forced fumbles.

- 2nd-team All-MEC.

REDSHIRT FRESHMAN (2014 AT NOTRE DAME

[OH]): Played in 9 games with 6 starts; 26 tackles (18 solo) and 5 sacks.

- Did not play football at California (PA) in 2013.
- Redshirted at California (PA) in 2012.
