



NFL CAREER

TRANSACTIONS:

- 7th-round pick (234th overall) by Miami in the 2019 NFL Draft.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

- Played in 38 career games with 17 starts.
- 361 carries for 1,355 yards (3.8 avg.) and 7 TDs.
- 101 receptions for 701 yards (6.9 avg.) and 6 TDs.
- In 2020, he finished 10th in the NFL in scrimmage yards per game (97.2, min. 10 games).

2022 (MIAMI):

- Played in 4 games.
- Inactive for 11 games.
- Missed the rest of the season after being placed on injured reserve on Dec. 27.
- 10 carries for 26 yards (2.6 avg.)
- 4 receptions for 28 yards (7.0 avg.).

VS. HOUSTON (11/27): 6 carries for 17 yards (2.8 avg.); 1 reception for 4 yards.

2021 (MIAMI):

- Played in all 17 games with 10 starts.
- 173 carries for 612 yards (3.5 avg.) and 3 TDs.
- 49 receptions for 234 yards (4.8 avg.) and 4 TDs.
- 1 miscellaneous fumble recovery.

AT TAMPA BAY (10/10): 5 carries for 25 yards (5.0 avg.); 10 receptions for 74 yards (7.4 avg.) and 2 TDs.

- Caught a 24-yard TD pass from QB Jacoby Brissett in the 1st quarter.
- Caught a 1-yard TD pass from QB Jacoby Brissett in the 3rd quarter.
- His 10 receptions tied for the most by a Dolphins RB in a single game.
- Became the 1st player in team history whose primary position was RB to have multiple games with at least 2 TD receptions.

AT N.Y. JETS (11/21): 23 carries for 89 yards (3.9 avg.); 3 receptions for 7 yards (2.3 avg.) and 1 TD.

- Caught a 5-yard TD pass from QB Tua Tagovailoa in the 4th quarter.
- VS. CAROLINA (11/28):** 16 carries for 49 yards (3.1 avg.) and 2 TDs; 2 receptions for 3 yards (1.5 avg.).
- Scored on a 3-yard TD run in the 2nd quarter to extend Miami's lead to 21-7.

- Scored on a 3-yard TD run in the 3rd quarter to extend Miami's lead to 27-10.

2020 (MIAMI):

- Played in 10 games with 7 starts.
- Spent 1 game on the Reserve/COVID-19 list.
- Activated off injured reserve on Dec. 5.
- Missed 4 games after being placed on injured reserve on Nov. 5.
- 142 carries for 584 yards (4.1 avg.) and 3 TDs.
- 41 receptions for 388 yards (9.5 avg.) and 2 TDs.
- His 97.2 scrimmage yards per game were 10th in the NFL (min. 10 games).

AT SAN FRANCISCO (10/11): 16 carries for 57 yards (3.6 avg.) and 1 TD; 5 receptions for 34 yards (6.8 avg.).

- Scored on a 1-yard TD run in the 1st quarter to extend Miami's lead to 14-0.

VS. L.A. RAMS (11/1): 18 carries for 47 yards (2.6 avg.) and 1 TD; 3 receptions for 16 yards (5.3 avg.).

- Scored on a 1-yard TD run in the 2nd quarter to extend Miami's lead to 28-7.

AT LAS VEGAS (12/26): 14 carries for 87 yards (6.2 avg.); 5 receptions for 82 yards (16.4 avg.) and 2 TDs.

- Caught a 10-yard TD pass from QB Tua Tagovailoa in the 3rd quarter to even the score at 13-13.
- Hauled in a 59-yard TD pass from QB Ryan Fitzpatrick in the 4th quarter to give Miami a 23-22 lead.
- Became the 1st Dolphins RB to have 2 receiving TDs in a game since RB Reggie Bush had 2 on Dec. 23, 2012 vs. Buffalo.
- His 169 scrimmage yards were the most by a Dolphin since RB Kenyan Drake vs. New England (Dec. 11, 2017).

2019 (MIAMI):

- Played in 7 games.
- Inactive for 8 games.
- Missed the final game of the season after being placed on injured reserve on Dec. 24.
- 36 carries for 133 yards (3.7 avg.) and 1 TD.
- 7 receptions for 51 yards (7.3 avg.).

AT INDIANAPOLIS (11/10): Played but did not record any stats.

- Made his NFL debut.

AT N.Y. GIANTS (12/15): 9 carries for 43 yards (4.8 avg.); 2 receptions for 29 yards (14.5 avg.).

VS. CINCINNATI (12/22): 16 carries for 55 yards (3.4 avg.) and 1 TD; 1 reception for 3 yards.

- Scored his 1st career TD on a 2-yard run in the 4th quarter to extend Miami's lead to 35-12.

BEFORE THE NFL

COLLEGE (WASHINGTON):

- 4-year starter (2015-18).

CAREER: Played in 52 games with 40 starts; 945 carries for 5,323 yards (5.6 avg.) and 57 TDs; 65 receptions for 465 yards (7.2 avg.) and 5 TDs; 6 kickoff returns for 90 yards (15.0 avg.); 1-of-1 passing for 2 yards and 1 TD.

- Finished his career as Washington's all-time leader in rushing yards (5,323), rushing TDs (57) and total TDs (62).
- His 5,323 rushing yards and 57 rushing TDs are both 3rd in Pac-12 history.
- Became the 1st player in Pac-12 history to record 1,000 rushing yards in 4 seasons.
- Became the 2nd player in FBS history to record 1,200 rushing yards in 4 seasons.

SENIOR (2018): Started 12 games; 259 carries for 1,268 yards (4.9 avg.) and 12 TDs; 21 receptions for 77 yards (3.7 avg.) and 1 TD; 4 kickoff returns for 74 yards (18.5 avg.); 1-of-1 passing for 2 yards and 1 TD.

- 2nd-team All-Pac-12.
- His 1,268 rushing yards were 4th in the Pac-12.
- His 12 rushing TDs were tied for 2nd in the Pac-12.

JUNIOR (2017): Played in all 13 games with 11 starts; 222 carries for 1,380 yards (6.2 avg.) and 21 TDs; 19 receptions for 232 yards (12.2 avg.) and 3 TDs; 1 kickoff return for 5 yards.

- 2nd-team All-Pac-12.
- His 21 rushing TDs led the Pac-12.

SOPHOMORE (2016): Played in all 14 games with 11 starts; 237 carries for 1,373 yards (5.8 avg.) and 10 TDs; 19 receptions for 137 yards (7.2 avg.) and 1 TD.

- 1st-team All-Pac-12.
- His 1,373 rushing yards ranked 3rd in the Pac-12.

TRUE FRESHMAN (2015): Played in all 13 games with 6 starts; 227 carries for 1,302 yards (5.7 avg.) and 14 TDs; 6 receptions for 19 yards (3.2 avg.); 1 kickoff return for 11 yards.

- Freshman All-American.
- Honorable mention All-Pac-12.
- His 14 rushing TDs were 3rd in the Pac-12.
- His 1,302 rushing yards were 4th in the Pac-12.
- Became the 1st true freshman in school history to rush for 1,000 yards.

- Played running back, safety and outside linebacker.
- Also lettered in track.
- Won state title in 100-meters in 2015.
