



## NFL CAREER

### TRANSACTIONS:

- 2nd-round pick (36th overall) by Miami in the 2021 NFL Draft.

### CAREER HONORS:

- 2023 PFWA All-AFC.
- 2021 PFWA All-Rookie Team
- NFL Way to Play Award (vs. Atlanta, 10/24/21)

### CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

- Played in 45 career games with 42 starts.
- 234 tackles (174 solo), 4.0 sacks, 5 interceptions, 21 passes defended, 4 forced fumbles and 4 fumble recoveries; 1 interception returned for a TD.
- 16 punt returns for 110 yards (6.9 avg.).
- 5 special teams tackles (3 solo).
- Started 1 postseason game.
- Is a 2-time team captain (2022-23).

### 2023 (MIAMI):

- Started 12 games.
- Inactive for 5 games.
- 73 tackles (51 solo), 1 interception, 4 passes defended, 3 forced fumbles and 1 fumble recovery; 1 interception returned for a TD.
- 1 solo special teams tackle.
- Served as a team captain.

**AT NEW ENGLAND (9/17):** 11 tackles (6 solo) and 1 pass defended.

- Split a tackle with LB Andrew Van Ginkel to stop OL Cole Strange inches from the line to gain on 4th-and-4 to force a turnover on downs and clinch the victory.

**VS. DENVER (9/24):** 8 tackles (7 solo), 1 pass defended and 3 forced fumbles.

- Stripped WR Courtland Sutton of the ball in the 2nd quarter which was recovered by LB Andrew Van Ginkel and returned to the Denver's 3-yard line.
- Forced WR Jerry Jeudy to fumble out of bounds on the 1st play of the 3rd quarter.
- Forced a WR Courtland Sutton fumble on 3rd-and-6 that was recovered by CB Kader Kohou.
- Became the 1st Dolphin since at least 1991 to force 3 fumbles in a game.

**AT N.Y. JETS (11/24):** 5 solo tackles, 1 interception

and 1 pass defended; 1 interception returned for a TD.

- Intercepted a Hail Mary attempt by QB Tim Boyle and returned it 99 yards for a TD on the final play of the 2nd quarter.
- It was the first score of his career.
- It was the longest interception return for a TD by a Dolphin since S Brock Marion (100t) vs. Buffalo on Jan. 6, 2002.

### POSTSEASON:

**AFC WILD CARD AT KANSAS CITY (1/13):** Inactive.

### HONORS:

### 2022 (MIAMI):

- Started all 17 games.
- 93 tackles (76 solo), 1.5 sacks, 2 interceptions, 7 passes defended and 1 forced fumble.
- 3 special teams tackles (1 solo).
- Served as a team captain.

**VS. NEW ENGLAND (9/11):** 3 solo tackles, 1 interception and 1 pass defended.

- Intercepted QB Mac Jones on the first defensive possession of the season after the pass was deflected by CB Xavier Howard.

**VS. BUFFALO (9/25):** 10 tackles (9 solo), 1.5 sacks, 2 passes defended and 1 forced fumble.

- Strip-sacked QB Josh Allen in the 1st quarter, which was recovered by LB Melvin Ingram.
- Split a sack with LB Jerome Baker on QB Josh Allen in the 4th quarter.

**VS. PITTSBURGH (9/23):** 5 tackles (4 solo), 1 interception and 1 pass defended.

- Intercepted QB Kenny Pickett on a 3rd-and-16 play with 3:06 remaining in the game, returning it 33 yards.

### POSTSEASON:

**AFC WILD CARD AT BUFFALO (1/15):** 9 tackles (8 solo), 1 interception and 2 passes defended; 1 solo special teams tackle.

- Intercepted QB Josh Allen in the 2nd quarter and returned it 29 yards to set up a Dolphins TD to tie the game just before halftime.

### 2021 (MIAMI):

- Played in 16 games with 13 starts.
- Inactive for 1 game.
- 68 tackles (47 solo), 2.5 sacks, 2 interceptions, 10 passes defended and 3 fumble recoveries.

- 12 punt returns for 92 yards (7.7 avg.).
- 1 solo special teams tackle.

**AT NEW ENGLAND (9/12):** 2 solo tackles.

- Made his NFL debut.

**VS. HOUSTON (11/7):** 2 tackles (1 solo), 1 interception and 1 pass defended; 3 punt returns for 31 yards (10.3 avg.).

- Intercepted QB Tyrod Taylor on 3rd-and-1 in the 1st quarter.

- It was his 1st career interception.

**VS. BALTIMORE (11/11):** 5 tackles (4 solo), 1.0 sack and 2 passes defended; 1 punt return for 4 yards.

- Sacked QB Lamar Jackson on 3rd-and-9 in the 3rd quarter.

**VS. CAROLINA (11/28):** 1 assisted tackle, 1 pass defended and 1 interception; 2 punt returns for 19 yards (9.5 avg.).

- Intercepted QB Cam Newton on 3rd-and-5 in the 2nd quarter.

### BEFORE THE NFL

#### COLLEGE (OREGON):

- 2-year letterman (2018-19) and 1-year starter.

**CAREER:** Played in 27 games with 16 starts; 110 tackles (72 solo), 9 interceptions and 19 passes defended; 1 interception return for a TD; 17 punt returns for 244 yards (14.4 avg.).

- Became the 1st player since Jairus Byrd (2006-07) to lead the team in interceptions in consecutive seasons (2018-19) at Oregon.

- His 9 interceptions from 2018-19 were tied for 3rd most in the FBS in that span.

**JUNIOR (2020):** Did not play.

**SOPHOMORE (2019):** Started all 14 games; 66 tackles (40 solo), 4 interceptions and 8 passes defended; 1 interception return for a TD; 16 punt returns for 244 yards (15.3 avg.).

- 1st-team All-Pac 12.

**TRUE FRESHMAN (2018):** Played in all 13 games with 2 starts; 44 tackles (32 solo), 5 interceptions and 11 passes defended; 1 punt return for 0 yards.

- Also played wide receiver.

**SENIOR (2017):** 34 tackles, 5 interceptions and 9 passes defended; 35 receptions for 1,012 receiving yards (28.9 avg.) and 12 TDs; 23 punt returns for 506 yards (22.0 avg.) and 5 TDs.
