- Signed by Miami on Jan. 10, 2017.
- Signed to Miami's practice squad on Nov. 22, 2016.
- Released from the N.Y. Jets practice squad on Nov. 15, 2016.
- Signed to the N.Y. Jets practice squad on Nov. 1, 2016.
- Waived by the N.Y. Jets on Aug. 28, 2016.
- Signed by the N.Y. Jets on Jan. 11, 2016.
- Waived by Seattle on Aug. 31, 2015.
- Signed by Seattle as an undrafted college free agent on May 2, 2015.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

- Played in 80 career games with 72 starts.
- 2 miscellaneous tackles.
- 2 miscellaneous fumble recoveries.
- Is only the third player in team history to start games at four different offensive line positions (RT, RG, LG and LT). Jeff Dellenbach started at all five positions while Nate Garner started at LG, C, RG and RT.
- Was the team's only player to participate in all 920 offensive snaps in 2018.
- Became 1 of 5 players in Dolphins history to start at 3 positions on the offensive line in a season (2017) and the only 1st-year player to do so.

- Played in all 17 games with 16 starts – 14 at right tackle and 2 at left guard.
- 1 miscellaneous fumble recovery.
- Served as a team captain.

AT NEW ENGLAND (9/12): Started at right tackle.

- Protected QB Tua Tagovailoa as the team did not allow a sack.

2020 (MIAMI):

- Played in all 16 games with 15 starts – 5 at right tackle, 4 at left tackle and 6 at right guard.

- Served as a team captain.

AT SAN FRANCISCO (10/11): Started at left tackle.

- Protected QB Ryan Fitzpatrick who posted the 3rd-best QB rating (154.5) in team history (min. 20 att.).

VS. L.A. CHARGERS (11/15): Started at right guard.

- Protected QB Tua Tagovailoa as the team did not allow a sack.
- It was the 1st time the Dolphins did not allow a sack in a game since Oct. 14, 2018 vs. Chicago.

VS. NEW ENGLAND (12/20): Started at right guard.

- Helped the team rush for 250 yards, which was Miami's most since Dec. 24, 2016 at Buffalo and the most allowed by New England since Nov. 24, 2013.

2019 (MIAMI):

- Started 15 games – 3 at left tackle and 12 at right tackle.
- Inactive for 1 game.

AT N.Y. GIANTS (12/15): Started at right tackle.

VS. CINCINNATI (12/22): Started at right tackle.

AT NEW ENGLAND (12/29): Started at right tackle.

2018 (MIAMI):

- Started all 16 games.
- Was the team's only player to participate in all 920 offensive snaps.

VS. OAKLAND (9/23): Started at right guard.

- Protected QB Ryan Tannehill, who completed 17-of-23 passes (73.9 pct.) for 289 yards and 3 TDs.
- Played 1 defensive snap.

VS. CHICAGO (10/14): Started at right guard.

- Protected QB Brock Osweiler, who completed 28-of-44 passes (63.6 pct.) for 380 yards and 3 TDs.
- Blocked for a running game that had 31 carries for 161 yards (5.2 avg.).

VS. NEW ENGLAND (12/9): Started at right guard.

- Protected QB Ryan Tannehill, who completed 14-of-19 passes (73.7 pct.) for 265 yards and 3 TDs.
- Blocked for a running game that had 21 carries for 189 yards (9.0 avg.) and 2 TDs.

2017 (MIAMI):

- Played in all 16 games with 10 starts.
- Started 6 games at right guard, 2 at left guard and 2 at right tackle.

- Became 1 of 5 players in Dolphins history to start at 3 positions on the offensive line in a season and the only 1st-year player to do so.

AT L.A. CHARGERS (9/17): Played 22 snaps at left guard.

- Made NFL debut.

AT BALTIMORE (10/26): Started at left guard.

- Made first NFL start.

VS. DENVER (12/3): Started at right guard.

- Blocked for RB Kenyan Drake, who rushed 23 times for 120 yards (5.2 avg.) and 1 TD.
- It was the 1st 100-yard rushing game of Drake's career.

defensive tackle; 13 tackles (7 solo), 1 pass defended and 1 fumble recovery.
