- Played in all 16 games.
- 4 special teams tackles (1 solo).

VS. TENNESSEE (9/9):

- Played but did not record any stats.
- Became the NFL leader among active players for consecutive games played.

AT INDIANAPOLIS (11/25):

- Played but did not record any stats.
- Became the second-oldest player to appear in a game in Dolphins history.

AT MINNESOTA (12/16):

- Played but did not record any stats.
- Joined QB Earl Morrall as the only players in Dolphins history to play in a game aged 40 or older.

2017 (MIAMI):

- Played in all 16 games.
- 2 special teams tackles (1 solo).
- Helped K Cody Parkey tie the team record for best field goal percentage in a single season (91.3 pct.).

VS. OAKLAND (11/5):

- Played but did not record any stats.
- Became the 20th active NFL player and the 313th player in NFL history to play in 200 career games.
- Served as a game captain.

PRO BOWL:

- Earned the 2nd Pro Bowl bid of his career as a coach's selection.
- Became the 1st Dolphins player to twice be selected to a Pro Bowl as a "need" player and also the first non-punting or kicking Dolphins special teams player to be twice named to an AFC Pro Bowl squad in team history.

- Played in all 16 games.
- 4 solo special teams tackles.

2010 (MIAMI):

- Played in all 16 games.
- 4 solo special teams tackles.

PRO BOWL:

- Earned his 1st Pro Bowl bid as a coach's selection.
- Became the 2nd Dolphins "need" player selected to a Pro Bowl team in franchise history, along with linebacker Zach Thomas in 2000.
- Became only the 2nd non-punting or kicking Dolphins special teams player named to an AFC Pro Bowl squad in Dolphins history, joining special teamer Larry Izzo, a 2000 selection.

CAREER: Played in 32 games with 29 starts; 93 tackles (44 solo), 9 sacks, 3 passes defended and 2 forced fumbles.

- Also handled long-snapping duties.

SENIOR (2004): Started 10 games; 27 tackles (13 solo), 4 sacks, 1 pass defended and 1 forced fumble.

- Selected for the Hula Bowl.

JUNIOR (2003): Started all 12 games; 41 tackles (23 solo), 4 sacks, 2 passes defended and 1 forced fumble.

REDSHIRT SOPHOMORE (2002): Played in 10 games with 7 starts; 25 tackles (8 solo) and 1 sack.

- Redshirted in 2001 after transferring to BYU.

TRUE FRESHMAN: (2000 AT RICKS JUNIOR COLLEGE): 51 tackles (21 solo) and 5 sacks.

- All-Region 18 honors.
- Helped team win the Real Dairy Bowl.
