2023 (MIAMI):

- Started 15 games.
- Inactive for 2 games.
- 209 carries for 1,012 yards (4.8 avg.) and 18 TDs.
- 25 receptions for 175 yards (7.0 avg.) and 3 TDs.
- His 21 total TDs and 18 rushing TDs were both single-season team records.
- His 18 rushing TDs led the NFL and were the 1st time a Dolphins player was the sole league leader in rushing TDs since 1972 (Mercury Morris).
- His 21 total TDs were tied for the NFL lead (Christian McCaffrey).

AT NEW ENGLAND (9/17): 18 carries for 121 yards (6.7 avg.) and 2 TDs; 1 reception for 6 yards (6.0 avg.).

- Scored on an 8-yard run with 9:39 left in the 2nd quarter to put Miami on the board.
- Scored on a 43-yard run with 8:45 left in the 4th quarter to extend Miami's lead to 24-10.
- Topped 100 rushing yards for the 1st time this season and 4th time in the regular season in his career.

VS. DENVER (9/24): 13 carries for 82 yards (6.3 avg.) and 3 TDs; 7 receptions for 60 yards (8.6 avg.) and 1 TD.

- Tied the franchise record for most total TDs (4) and points scored (24) in a game.
- Scored on a 20-yard run with 1:49 left in the 2nd quarter to give Miami a 28-10 lead.
- Scored Miami's 2nd TD in a span of 20 seconds on a 3-yard run with 1:29 left in the 2nd quarter.
- Scored on a 1-yard run in the 3rd quarter to extend Miami's lead to 42-13.
- Caught a 19-yard TD pass from QB Tua Tagovailoa in the 3rd quarter.

VS. CAROLINA (10/15): 17 carries for 115 yards (6.8 avg.) and 2 TDs; 3 receptions for 17 yards (5.7 avg.) and 1 TD.

- Caught a 3-yard TD pass from QB Tua Tagovailoa in the 2nd quarter.
- Scored on a 4-yard run in the 3rd quarter to extend Miami's lead to 28-14.
- Scored on a 1-yard run on Miami's first possession of the 4th quarter.

- Scored on a 3-yard run in the 4th quarter to give Miami a 20-13 lead.

- His 2 TDs gave him 16 rushing scores for the season and 18 total touchdowns, both tying single-season franchise records.

- At 31 years old, became the 2nd-oldest player in NFL history to score 20 TDs in a season. Only Washington RB John Riggins, who had 24 TDs in 1983 at 34 years old, was older.

- Caught a 4-yard TD pass from QB Tua Tagovailoa to give Miami a 13-7 lead with 17 seconds left in the 2nd quarter.
- At 31 years old, became the 2nd-oldest player in NFL history to rush for 1,000 yards for the 1st time in his career. Only Pittsburgh RB John Henry Johnson, who had 1,141 yards in 1962 at 33 years old, was older.
- Became the 1st Dolphin since 2016 (Jay Ajayi) to rush for 1,000 yards in a season.
