- Became 1st player in team history to record at least 100 tackles, 4 interceptions and 2 sacks in a season when he did so in 2015.
- His 5 interceptions in 2015 were the most by a Dolphins safety in a single season since 2002 (Brock Marion).
- Became the 1st player in team history to record an interception for a TD in consecutive games (at Tennessee, 10/18/15 and vs. Houston, 10/25/15).

- Missed the rest of the season after being placed on injured reserve on Nov. 20.
- 27 tackles (17 solo) and 1 pass defensed.

 Intercepted QB Marcus Mariota and returned it 26 yards in the third quarter.

 - It was the 1st multi-interception game by a Dolphins safety since Sammy Knight (12/20/04 vs. NE).
- AT CINCINNATI (10/7): 8 tackles (7 solo) and two passes defensed.
 - Tipped a QB Andy Dalton pass that was intercepted by LB Kiko Alonso in the 1st quarter.
- AT BUFFALO (12/30): 3 tackles (1 solo), 1 interception and 1 pass defensed.
 - Intercepted QB Josh Allen on 2nd-and-12, returning it 29 yards for a TD with 39 seconds remaining in the 2nd quarter to tie the game at 14.

2017 (MIAMI):

- Started all 16 games.
- 122 tackles (94 solo), 1.5 sacks, 2 interceptions, 5 passes defensed and 3 fumble recoveries; 2 fumble recovery TDs.
- His 122 tackles led all NFL safeties and ranked No. 6 in the AFC and No. 12 in the NFL among all players.
- Was the only NFL player to have 2 fumble recoveries for TDs.
- VS. TENNESSEE (10/8): 7 tackles (6 solo), 0.5 sacks and 2 fumble recoveries.
 - Recovered a QB Matt Cassel fumble that was forced by LB Kiko Alonso and returned it 38 yards for a TD to put Miami up 10-0 in the 1st quarter.
 - It was his 1st career fumble recovery for a TD.
 - Also recovered a RB DeMarco Murray fumble that was forced by DT Davon Godchaux in the 1st quarter.
- Split a sack with DE Cameron Wake for a loss of 9 yards on 3rd-and-9, forcing Tennessee to punt in the 3rd quarter.
- AT ATLANTA (10/15): 7 tackles (5 solo), 1 interception and 1 pass defensed.
 - Intercepted a QB Matt Ryan pass intended for TE Austin Hooper with 47 seconds remaining to seal the game for Miami.
 - Also served as a game captain.
- AT NEW ENGLAND (11/26): 13 tackles (10 solo) and 1 fumble recovery.
 - Returned a fumble 14 yards for a 2nd quarter TD after a premature snap by the Patriots.
 - It was the 5th defensive TD of Jones' career and his 2nd of the season.

PRO BOWL:

- Selected to start the Pro Bowl for the 2nd time in his career.
- Extended the team's streak to 20 consecutive seasons with a defensive player selected.
- Became the 4th Dolphins safety to earn multiple Pro Bowl selections, joining Jake Scott (5 times; 1971-75), Dick Anderson (3; 1972-74) and Brock

Marion (3; 2000, 2003-04).

2016 (MIAMI):

- Started 6 games.
- Missed 10 games after being placed on injured reserve on Oct. 19.
- 51 tackles (31 solo), 0.5 sacks, 1 interception and 4 passes defensed.
- Voted by teammates to be a season-long captain.
- AT SEATTLE (9/11): 12 tackles (6 solo) and 1 pass defensed.
- VS. CLEVELAND (9/25): 10 tackles (9 solo), 0.5 sacks and 1 pass defensed.
 - Split a sack of QB Cody Kessler with DT Ndamukong Suh for a loss of 0.5 yards.
- VS. PITTSBURGH (10/16): 5 tackles (4 solo), 1 interception and 1 pass defensed.
- Intercepted a QB Ben Roethlisberger pass, returning it 17 yards.

- His 5 interceptions were the most by a Dolphins safety in a single season since 2002 (Brock Marion).
- His 135 tackles led all NFL defensive backs.
- Became the 1st player in team history to record an interception for a TD in consecutive games (at Tennessee, 10/18 and vs. Houston, 10/25).

AT JACKSONVILLE (9/20): 11 tackles (8 solo).

- Along with LB Jelani Jenkins, recorded doubledigit tackles for the 2nd consecutive week, which marked the 1st time a Dolphins player recorded double-digit tackles in the first 2 weeks of the season since LB Zach Thomas in 2007.
- AT TENNESSEE (10/18): 8 tackles (5 solo) and 1 interception.
 - His 30-yard interception return for a TD in the 3rd guarter was the 2nd score of his NFL career.
- VS. HOUSTON (10/25): 8 solo tackles and 1 interception.
 - Returned an interception of QB Brian Hoyer 23 yards for a TD in the 2nd quarter.
 - Became 1st player in team history to record an interception return for a TD in consecutive games.

PRO BOWL:

- Earned his 1st Pro Bowl selection and was chosen to start the game.
- Joined CB Brent Grimes on the roster and marked the 1st time since following the 2003 season (CB Patrick Surtain and S Brock Marion) the Dolphins had two defensive backs selected to the Pro Bowl in the same season.
- Became the 1st Dolphins safety to earn a Pro Bowl selection since S Yeremiah Bell following

the 2009 season.

• Became the 6th safety in team history to go to the Pro Bowl.

- Missed the first 4 games due to suspension.

- **AT CHICAGO (10/19):** 7 solo tackles, 1 interception and 2 passes defensed.
 - Intercepted QB Jay Cutler and returned it 50 yards in the 2nd quarter.
- VS. SAN DIEGO (11/2): 5 solo tackles and 1 interception.
 - Intercepted QB Philip Rivers and returned it 16 yards in the 2nd quarter.
- AT N.Y. JETS (12/1): 10 tackles (9 solo) and 1 interception.
 - Intercepted QB Geno Smith near midfield to end a Jets comeback attempt on their final snap of the game.
