



## NFL CAREER

### TRANSACTIONS:

- Signed by Miami as an unrestricted free agent from the L.A. Rams on March 31, 2017.
- 3rd-round pick (71st overall) by St. Louis in the 2013 NFL draft.

### CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

- Started 75 career games.
- 410 tackles (309 solo), 5 sacks, 8 interceptions, 25 passes defended, 1 forced fumble and 3 fumble recoveries.

### 2018 (MIAMI):

- Started 14 games.
- Inactive for 2 games.
- 84 tackles (62 solo), 3 interceptions, 5 passes defended and 1 fumble recovery.
- 1 special teams tackle.

**AT N.Y. JETS (9/16):** 1 solo tackle, 1 interception and 1 pass defended.

- Intercepted a QB Sam Darnold pass and returned it 31 yards to the Jets' 15-yard line, setting up a RB Kenyan Drake 6-yard TD run to put Miami up 7-0 in the 1st quarter.

**VS. CHICAGO (10/14):** 3 tackles (2 solo), 1 interception and 1 pass defended.

- Intercepted QB Mitch Trubisky in the end zone with 12:21 remaining in 4th quarter.

**VS. N.Y. JETS (11/4):** 9 tackles (8 solo), 1 interception and 2 passes defended.

- Intercepted QB Sam Darnold on 4th-and-15 with 2:22 remaining in the game.

- Sacked QB Carson Palmer on a 3rd-and-2 inside the red zone in the 3rd quarter, forcing Arizona to kick a field goal.

- Stripped WR Travis Benjamin of the ball, which was recovered by St. Louis and led to a 4th-quarter TD drive.

### 2014 (ST. LOUIS):

- Started all 16 games.
- 104 tackles (84 solo), 2 sacks, 1 interception and 6 passes defended.
- 1 blocked field goal; 1 blocked punt.

**AT TAMPA BAY (9/14):** 5 solo tackles; 1 blocked field goal; 1 blocked punt.

- Blocked a punt by P Michael Koenen in the 2nd quarter, which led to a St. Louis field goal.

- Blocked a 24-yard field goal attempt by K Patrick Murray in the 4th quarter to keep it a 1-possession game.

- It was the 1st time since Dec. 2, 1979 the Rams blocked two kicks in the same game.

**AT WASHINGTON (12/7):** 4 assisted tackles and 1 interception.

- Intercepted QB Colt McCoy in the 4th quarter and returned it 20 yards.

**VS. N.Y. GIANTS (12/21):** 11 tackles (9 solo) and 1 sack.

### 2013 (ST. LOUIS):

- Started 10 games.
- Missed 6 games after he was placed on injured reserve/designated to return on Sept. 27.
- 53 tackles (45 solo), 1 sack, 1 interception and 4 passes defended.

**VS. ARIZONA (9/8):** 5 tackles (4 solo) and 1 pass defended.

- Made NFL debut and started his 1st NFL game.

**VS. NEW ORLEANS (12/15):** 5 tackles (4 solo) and 1 interception.

- Intercepted QB Drew Brees on New Orleans' 1st play from scrimmage to set up a St. Louis TD drive.
- It was his 1st career interception.

**VS. TAMPA BAY (12/22):** 6 solo tackles and 1 sack.

- Brought down QB Mike Glennon for a 9-yard loss for his 1st career sack.
