- Became the 1st Dolphins player to record back-to-back 100-yard receiving games since WR DeVante Parker did so on Dec. 22, 2019 vs. Cincinnati (111) and Dec. 29, 2019 at New England (137).

- Caught TD passes of 5 and 29 yards from QB Tua Tagovailoa in the 1st half.
- Marked his 3rd consecutive game with at least 85 receiving yards.
