STEPHEN ROSS AND THE MIAMI DOLPHINS PLEDGE \$500,000 TO SUPPORT ELDERLY AND YOUTH IMPACTED BY COVID-19

MIAMI GARDENS, Fla. – Stephen Ross and the Miami Dolphins announced a pledge of \$500,000 to help meet critical needs for elderly and youth in the community as a result of the global COVID-19 pandemic. These funds will be used to support school meal programs for Broward County Public Schools and Miami-Dade County Public Schools, relief efforts led by churches in Miami Gardens and to bolster programs from Feeding South Florida to provide access to food for underserved populations in the area.

"This is obviously an unprecedented situation that is affecting everyone; and affecting some people a lot more than others. We want to help those who are most vulnerable and those right here in our backyard," said Miami Dolphins Vice Chairman and CEO Tom Garfinkel. "We will continue to monitor the situation with our community partners and strongly encourage everyone to stay home and follow the CDC guidelines. We will get through this together."

In addition, the team will work with Miami Dolphins FOOTBALL UNITES™ partners that are on the front lines responding to the outbreak. Details around these programs will be shared once finalized.

MIAMI DOLPHIN ALUMNI RESTAURATEURS TEAM UP TO PROVIDE FOOD RELIEF

\$250,000 grant from Miami Dolphin owner Stephen Ross to seed larger community effort, all while helping to keep restaurant employees working

MIAMI GARDENS, Fla. – Four former Miami Dolphin stars who are engaged in the food service industry have teamed up to provide free meals to vulnerable populations who have been severely impacted by the COVID-19 crisis, all while helping to keep workers from their restaurants employed.

John Offerdahl (Offerdahl's Off-The-Grill), Kim Bokamper (Bokamper's Sports Bar & Grill), Bob Brudzinski (Bru's Room Sports Grill) and legendary Coach Don Shula have teamed up to provide lunch and dinner options to the most at-risk.

The program, made possible by a \$250,000 grant from Miami Dolphins owner Stephen Ross through the Miami Dolphins Foundation, lays the groundwork for a multi-faceted program designed to keep as many people fed as possible, all while keeping food service industry workers employed.

In order to apply for emergency meal kits, interested non-profit organizations may email FEEDTHENEEDSouthFlorida@gmail.com. Once the organization and their request are vetted, they will be notified as to the specifics of meal drop-offs pending need and available funds.

"The magnitude of the impact of both the health and economic crisis on our most vulnerable populations cannot be overstated," said John Offerdahl. "Many of these individuals simply do not have the resources and the physical means to provide food for their families. This grant is an initial step towards a much broader effort to help at-risk populations, all while keeping food service employees working."

The program brings individually pre-wrapped meals to vetted 1st responders, healthcare and non-profit organizations at a designated drop-off location. This allows for social distancing and creates the most hygienic environment. The organizations then distribute the meals to their constituents. Breakfast, lunch and dinner options are available.

MIAMI WITH THREE FIRST-ROUND PICKS

The Miami Dolphins currently hold the fifth, 18th and 26th selections in the first round of the draft. If Miami uses all three picks, **it'll be the first time in franchise history the Dolphins have drafted three players in the first round of the same draft.** Miami has drafted multiple players in the same first round on five different occasions but not since 1992 when they took **CB Troy Vincent** at No. 7 overall and **LB Marco Coleman** at No. 12 overall.

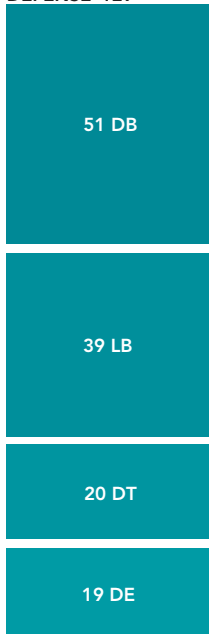

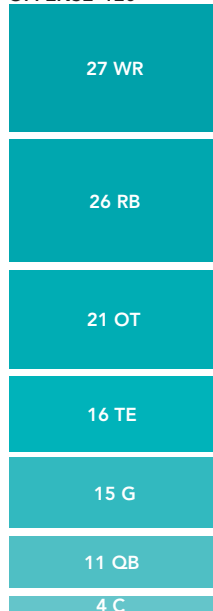

DOLPHINS IN THE FIRST ROUND

THE DOLPHINS' TOP CHOICE

The Dolphins have used a first-round pick to select a variety of positions with the defensive line producing 12 players – the most of any position. Miami has used its top pick overall to select an offensive lineman 13 times, which is the most in franchise history. Conversely, the Dolphins have never used their top pick to select a kicker or punter and only once has the team used their first selection in a draft to pick a tight end. The only tight end selected with the team's top pick came in 1970 when Jim Mandich was the team's second-round pick.

The chart on the right shows the breakdown of the Dolphins' top picks as well as first-round selections by position.

The Dolphins have used their first-round selections to draft a variety of positions, but the team has yet to use the pick on a tight end or a specialist. It has been 36 drafts since the Dolphins selected a guard in the first round, the longest period Miami has not picked a player from a certain position group.

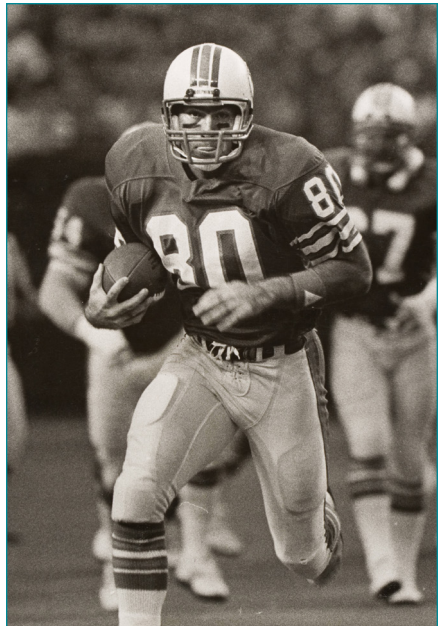

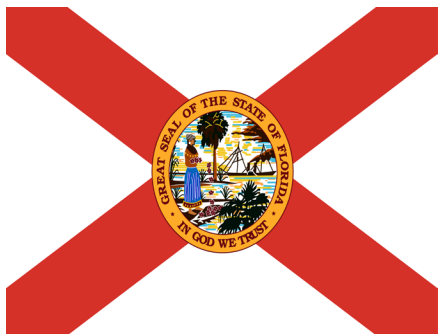
DRAFT NOTES

HOMEGROWN TALENT

The Dolphins have selected a player from a Florida university in 25 of the team's 54 college drafts. Overall, the Dolphins have drafted 46 players from a Florida school.

The University of Miami leads the way with 17 Dolphins draftees, followed by 14 from the University of Florida, eight from Florida State University, four from the University of Tampa, two from Bethune-Cookman University and one from Florida A&M University. With the selection of center Mike Pouncey out of the University of Florida in 2011, the Dolphins have selected a player from the state of Florida eight times in the first round.

2020 NFL COMPENSATORY PICKS

The NFL awarded a total of 32 compensatory choices to 15 teams in the 2020 NFL draft. Since 1994, when the NFL began awarding compensatory picks, Miami has been awarded 20 compensatory selections. The Dolphins are scheduled to have two compensatory picks in the 2020 NFL draft.

Under the rules for compensatory draft selections, a team losing more or better compensatory free agents than it acquires in the previous year is eligible to receive compensatory draft picks.

The compensatory picks will be positioned within the third through seventh rounds based on the value of the compensatory free agents lost.

Compensatory picks may be traded. A rule change approved by clubs in 2015 permits compensatory draft picks to be traded beginning in 2017.

Compensatory free agents are determined by a formula based on salary, playing time and postseason honors. The formula was developed by the NFL Management Council. Not every free agent lost or signed by a club is covered by this formula.

DOLPHINS COMPENSATORY PICKS HISTORY

The Dolphins have been awarded 22 compensatory picks since 1994 when the NFL instituted the current formula for awarding teams that have net losses during free agency. The Dolphins only selected players with 19 of those, as they traded one during the 2017 NFL draft and have two scheduled for the 2020 NFL draft.

Miami has been awarded compensatory picks in 12 of the 27 drafts (since 1994). The most compensatory selections made by the team in one draft occurred in 2003 when four players were selected with compensatory picks.

The highest compensatory selection made by the Dolphins came in 1997 when linebacker Derrick Rodgers was picked in the third round with the 92nd overall selection.

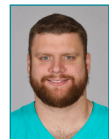
