MIAMI DOLPHINS (6-3) AT KANSAS CITY CHIEFS (7-2) IN FRANKFURT | SUNDAY, NOV. 5, 2023 | 3:30 P.M. CET

DOLPHINS DEFENSE LIMITS HIGH-POWERED CHIEFS ATTACK TO JUST 267 YARDS

- The Miami Dolphins allowed the Chiefs offense to score just 14 points, total 267 yards and only 174 passing yards.
- The 267 yards and 174 passing yards for Kansas City were both the Chiefs' fewest in a regular-season game since Nov. 7, 2021 vs. Green Bay (237 and 160, respectively).
 - The Chiefs entered the game averaging 381.5 total yards per game, fourth-best in the NFL entering Week 9.
 - The last time two-time MVP **QB Patrick Mahomes** passed for less than 200 yards in a regular-season game was Dec. 5, 2021 vs. Denver, when he had 184 passing yards.
- The Dolphins have allowed less than 110 rushing yards in eight consecutive games. The last time the Dolphins had such a streak was a 10-game run from Oct. 17, 2021 to Dec. 27, 2021.
 - This eight-game run is the fourth-longest such streak in team history.
- Miami has now held its opponent to 200 passing yards or less in six of its nine games this season, including four of the past five.
- The Dolphins have allowed opponents to gain less than 300 yards in five games this season, including four of the past five.
- Kansas City's 16 first downs today was their fewest in a regular-season game since Dec. 24, 2022 vs. Seattle (14).

CHUBB FORCES HIS FOURTH FUMBLE OF THE SEASON

- Facing third down in the third quarter, **LB Bradley Chubb** was able to strip-sack Chiefs **QB Patrick Mahomes** of the football, which was recovered by **DT Zach Sieler**.
- It was Chubb's fourth forced fumble of the season, and third in his past four games, tying Cleveland **DE Myles Garrett** and Kansas City **CB Trent McDuffie** for the most in the NFL this year (at the end of today's Frankfurt game).

- Chubb has now recorded a sack in four consecutive games and has a team-leading six sacks this season.
- He has five sacks in his past four games and is tied with Baltimore **DL Justin Madubuike** for most sacks in the NFL since Week 6.
- Chubb recorded his 10th quarterback hit of the season and has a QB hit now in eight straight games. The only other NFL player to have a quarterback hit in eight straight contests this season is San Francisco **DE Nick Bosa** (at the end of today's Frankfurt game).
- In Chubb's past five games, he has totaled 26 tackles (18 solo), 5.0 sacks, six quarterback hits, four tackles for loss, three forced fumbles and one pass defended.

MOSTERT EXTENDS HIS NFL LEAD WITH 11TH RUSHING SCORE OF SEASON

- **RB Raheem Mostert** had a 13-yard rushing touchdown near the end of the third quarter to pull the Dolphins within one score at 21-14.
- It was Mostert's 11th rushing touchdown of the season, which leads the NFL (at the end of today's Frankfurt game).
- Mostert now has a touchdown in seven of nine games this season and a rushing score in four of his past five games.
- His 13 total touchdowns (11 rushing and 2 receiving) is tied with San Francisco **RB Christian McCaffrey** for most in the NFL (at the end of today's Frankfurt game).
- The score was the 25th rushing touchdown of Mostert's career.
- Mostert rushed for 85 yards on 12 carries (7.1 avg.). It improves his career rushing average to 5.41, which is the NFL's best in the Super Bowl era by any running back with at least 500 carries.
- Mostert has now topped 50+ scrimmage yards in seven of nine games this season.

- There were 50,023 tickets distributed to today's game.
- **S DeShon Elliott** played in his 50th NFL game today.
- **LB Jaelan Phillips** recorded a sack in his third consecutive game and has 3.5 sacks in six games played this season.
- **DT Christian Wilkins** had a quarterback hit and now has 12 on the season, which is tied for fourth-most among NFL defensive tackles this season (at the end of the Frankfurt game).
- **WR Cedrick Wilson Jr.** caught a 31-yard touchdown pass from **QB Tua Tagovailoa** in the third quarter. It was his second touchdown reception in as many games.
 - This is the third different occasion Wilson has scored in back-to-back games. The last Jan. 2, 2022 (1) vs. Arizona and Jan. 8, 2022 (2) at Philadelphia, when Wilson played for Dallas.
