Aldrick Robinson (pronounced AL-drick) joined the Miami Dolphins as an offensive assistant in 2022.

Robinson joined the Dolphins after spending nine seasons as an NFL wide receiver. He spent time with Washington (2011-14), Baltimore (2014-15), Atlanta (2016), San Francisco (2017-18), Minnesota (2018) and Carolina (2019). He played in a total of 82 games with five starts, recording 86 receptions for 1,422 yards (16.5 avg.) and 14 touchdowns. He also played in four playoff games.

Robinson's last regular-season playing action came in 2018 with Minnesota, when he appeared in 14 games. He caught 17 passes for 231 yards (13.6 avg.) and five touchdowns.

He appeared in all 16 games with one start for San Francisco in 2017, recording 19 receptions for 260 yards (13.7 avg.) and two touchdowns.

In 2016, Robinson played in all 16 games and made one start for the Falcons team that won the NFC and advanced to Super Bowl LI. He had a career-high 20 receptions that season and accumulated 323 yards (16.2 avg.) and two touchdowns. Robinson also appeared in all three playoff games.

He spent the offseason and training camp with Baltimore in 2015.

From 2012-14, Robinson played in 36 games with three starts for Washington. In 2013, he totaled a career-high 365 receiving yards on 18 receptions (20.3 avg.) and two touchdowns. He appeared in his first 15 games in 2012, helping Washington earn a playoff berth.

Robinson originally entered the NFL as a sixth-round pick (178th overall) by Washington in the 2011 NFL Draft.

Robinson played collegiately at SMU, where he finished his career second in school history in all-time receiving yards (3,314) and fourth in receptions (181). As a senior in 2010, he earned first-team All-Conference USA honors while totaling 1,301 receiving yards and catching a school-record 14 touchdowns. Robinson majored in philosophy.
