### NFL CAREER

#### TRANSACTIONS:

- Signed to Miami's practice squad on Sept. 14, 2020.
- Waived by Tampa Bay on Sept. 8, 2020.
- Signed by Tampa Bay as an undrafted college free agent on May 4, 2020.

- Dressed but did not play in 2 games.

#### COLLEGE (SAN DIEGO):

- 4-year letterman (2016-19) and 1-year starter.

**CAREER:** Played in 45 games with 12 starts; 275-of-423 passing (65.0 pct.) and 33 TDs; 93 carries for 268 yards (2.9 avg.) and 7 TDs; 1 reception for 30 yards.

**SENIOR (2019):** Started all 12 games; 251-of-375 passing (66.9 pct.) for 3,528 yards and 32 TDs; 63 carries for 174 yards (2.8 avg.) and 6 TDs; 1 reception for 30 yards.

**JUNIOR (2018):** Played in 11 games; 3-of-7 passing (42.9 pct.) for 34 yards; 6 carries for 30 yards (5.0 avg.).

**SOPHOMORE (2017):** Played in 10 games; 11-of-24 passing (45.8 pct.) for 101 yards and 1 TD; 14 carries for 41 yards (2.9 avg.) and 1 TD.

**REDSHIRT FRESHMAN (2016):** Played in all 12 games; 10-of-17 passing (58.8 pct.) for 181 yards; 10 carries for 23 yards (2.3 avg.).
